## INFORMATION AND INVITATION

Old Boys Praha have pleasure to invite you to 3rd Old-Prague Ham - International Rugby Veteran Games (hereinafter stated as "Event"), taking place from June 10-12, 2011 in Prague, Czech Republic under the following conditions:



### I. PROGRAMM:

- Friday June 10 in the afternoon: Welcome Drink
- Saturday June 11 - the whole day: Games, Lunch, Afterparty
- Sunday June 12: Optional Programme (Trips) on Request

### II. FORMAT OF THE EVENT

**Age of Players:** All players must be of age 35 and/or more. For Platinum Category the minimal age is 50 years.

**Number of Teams:** As the Event is limited to 10 teams, please, make your registration in a good time.

**Rules of the Games:** standard XV rugby rules incl. usual veteran modifications (no push in scrums, no kicking outside 22m zone and no lifting in outlines).

### III. ENTRY FEES:

50 EUR/person (regardless if player or non-player) covers as follows:

- Welcome Drink, incl. consumption of drinks and refreshments
- Transport from hotel to the pitch and back (only 1 bus per team) - **both items applicable only for teams accommodated at Partner Hotels,**
- Lunch and 3 drinks on the pitch
- Event souvenirs for each participant and prizes for all teams.

#### V. PROCESS OF REGISTRATION

Only teams who would fill in and send the enclosed Entry Form to the Event's Secretary ([andrej.hronec@seznam.cz](mailto:andrej.hronec@seznam.cz)) and further follow the necessary instructions may become participants of the Event. Registration shall be completed only after the Entry Fees has been fully paid. Teams are accepted on the "first come-first served" basis.

##### Deadlines:

**January 31, 2011 for registration of teams** (sending filled in Entry Forms)

**March 31, 2011 for paying full Entry Fees**, Accommodation fees and sending final lists of participants for accommodation.

#### VI. LOCAL TRANSPORT AND OPTIONAL PROGRAMME

The Entry Fees cover bus transfers from Partner Hotel to the pitch and back only. Any other transports should be arranged separately and on request (i.a. **we can offer bus from airport to the hotel and back for EUR 295,-**) . The Organising Committee is finalizing an Option Programme incl. Price List for Sunday June 12, 2011 which will be published in a good time.

## VII. LIABILITIES

All participants must respect rules and regulations of the Event for the games as well as laws and regulations valid in Prague and the Czech Republic. ## FROM HISTORY OF THE EVENT

### OLD BOYS PRAHA



1988-2008

Old Boys Praha - the only Czech purely veteran rugby club, was founded in 1988 and since then reached a number of good achievements.

Old Boys Praha organizes from time to time international rugby veteran events called **Old Golden Prague**. We have already hosted 48 teams from 17 different countries from the whole Europe and also overseas (North America).

Up to now, 4 Old Golden Prague Events were organised: first of which in 1994 and the last one - 4th Old Golden Prague / 6th Georg Holek Cup - International Rugby Veteran Event on the occasion of 20th anniversary of Old Boys Praha and the whole Czech rugby veteran movement in 2008 which was the greatest event in history with 17 teams from 12 countries from Europe and North America....

In 2009, Old Boys Praha started a new series of mini-tournaments on the each-year basis for 6-12 teams. These events have been called **OLD-PRAGUE HAM** and the first one took place on June 19-21, 2009 with the 6 teams from Italy, Czech Republic and Spain. During 2<sup>nd</sup> Old Prague-Ham in 2010 we hosted already 12 teams from Italy, France, Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary and Spain.
